



MAKING LOCAL ANESTHESIA MORE EFFECTIVE AND COMFORTABLE

Patients do not want to experience pain during their dental treatment. Fortunately, local anesthesia forms the backbone of dentistry pain control techniques. Local anesthetics are the safest, most effective drugs for the prevention and management of pain, yet occasionally, achieving profound anesthesia painlessly can be challenging.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

In this program, we will discuss how to provide more effective and comfortable local anesthetic injections. Topics include: an algorithm for more successful mandibular anesthesia, buffering (the local anesthetic “on switch”), and articaine (dentistry’s newest and most interesting local anesthetic). 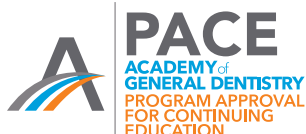
